WHEREAS, the contributions John Hesch has made toward the field of behavioral health in Minneapolis have fostered healthy relationships and resources for the future of the region; and

WHEREAS, the Twin Cities Men's Center, founded in 1976, recognizes the impact of John Hesch's leadership working with men actively navigating the justice system; and

WHEREAS, upon the announcement of his retirement, John Hesch will culminate a 25-year career as a men's health facilitator.
